Following the wreath laying U.S. Mark Alexander Milley United States Army general and the 20th Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff. As Chairman, he is the highest-ranking and most senior military officer in the United States Armed Forces. Meets with Andy his service dog Millie and Founder/Trainer Ken Knabenshue. Other recent news Saturday, September 26th in a continued national campaign for military suicide awareness a walk-a-thon in Washington, DC Followed by a Wreath Laying at the Vietnam Wall. 


