- Contact us, fill out, and send in our application
- We help you work with local shelters to identify a suitable candidate to become your Service Dog.
- You adopt your new Battle Buddy and agree to provide it a good life and on-time veterinary care.
- Let's get training! We help you establish "house rules" and get you started with training basics.
- Once you and your dog have a good working relationship and have mastered the basics, we will introduce you to Advanced Obedience tasks. You will also begin working your dog in public.
- We will help you identify tasks your dog should master in order to assist you with your disability, and then begin a training regimen to teach those tasks.
- Once all of our requirements have been met by both dog and handler, you will graduate!
